As for the problem of the research, it is reflected in the lack of sources documenting the participation of the Iraqi national football team in the Arab Gulf championships from 1970 to 2014, so the researcher decided to delve into this vital field with narration, documentation, analysis and criticism in order to serve the edifice of scientific research in our dear country.

The aim of the study includes:

.1 Documenting the results of the Iraqi national team for the Arab Gulf football championships from 1976 AD - 2014 AD..

.2 Analysis of the results of the Iraqi national team for the Arab Gulf football championships from 1976 AD - 2014 AD.

As for the second chapter, it included a historical overview of football in ancient civilizations, the development of its history in the Middle Ages and the actual establishment of its federation globally, as well as its historical development and stages of its inception and the actual establishment of its federation in Iraq, as well as years in the beginnings of football and the historical overview of the Arab Gulf courses and the results of the Arab Gulf courses From 1970 AD until 2014 AD, the second chapter also included previous studies and their discussion.

As for the third chapter, it included the research methodology and field procedures:

The researcher used the historical method for its suitability to the research problem, and the research sample included the results of the Iraqi national football team players in the Arab Gulf championships and the participant in (13 championships) from 1976 AD until 2014. The researcher also used statistical methods to extract the data.

As for the fourth chapter, it included presenting the results of the Iraqi national team for the Arab Gulf sessions, picking them up and discussing them in a modern scientific style.

As for the fifth chapter, it included conclusions and recommendations, and the most prominent conclusions were:

.1 The Arab Gulf tournaments began in 1970, and the first participation of the Iraqi national football team was in 1976, in the fourth session held in the State of Qatar.

.2 The number of the Iraqi national football team's participation in the Arab Gulf tournaments from 1976 to 2014 reached 13, including Iraq's withdrawal from the sixth Arab Gulf tournament held in Abu Dhabi (UAE) in 1982, as well as its withdrawal in the Arab Gulf tournament. (10) established in the State of (Kuwait) in 1990 AD.

.3 There are periods of complete interruption from the Arab Gulf tournaments for the Iraqi football team in the tournaments (from 1992 to 2003.)

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.4The Iraqi national team won first place in the Arab Gulf tournaments in the years (1979, 1984 and 1988), and ranked second in the years (1976 and 2013).(

The recommendations included:

.1The necessity of conducting a similar study on the Iraqi national team participating in the Asian tournaments and tournaments for the period from 1951 to 2014.

.2The necessity of conducting a similar study on the Iraqi national team for youth under 19 years in the period from 1975 to 2014.

.3The necessity of recording the sports events of the Iraqi team's participation, the names of the players and the achievements they obtained in the international, Asian and Arab tournaments and tournaments, and placing them in an archive with the Central Football Association and the colleges of physical education and sports sciences and their departments in Iraq.

.4Adopting this study as a source from the Iraqi Central Football Association, the Iraqi National Olympic Committee and the Library of the College of Physical Education and Sports Sciences / Universities of Iraq, and put it at the disposal of researchers and scholars to benefit from it in other research.

.5The researcher recommends the independence of sport from politics.
